By public transport

Our office is easily accessible by public transport. The Symphony building is a two minute walk from Amsterdam Zuid station (train, tram, metro, bus).

- Get off at Amsterdam Zuid.
- Take the station exit Mahler. You will arrive at the Gustav Mahlersquare.
- Symphony building (orange) is located across the street from the square.
- Take the second entrance: No. 117.

Metro to Amsterdam Zuid

From Amsterdam Sloterdijk: metro 50. Direction: Gein.

From Duivendrecht or Bijlmer / Arena: Metro 50. Direction: Isolatorweg.

From Amsterdam Central Station or Amstel Station: Metro 51. Direction: Westwijk.

Train to Amsterdam Zuid

From Schiphol Airport: train with direction Leeuwarden OR Nijmegen OR Enschede.

From The Hague station: train with direction Groningen.

From Utrecht station: train with direction Schiphol.

By car

From Utrecht / Amersfoort

From ring road A10, take exit S109 Amsterdam Buitenveldert.

At the end of the exit turn left (signposted Zuidas). First road turn right at the traffic lights. You are now on the Boelelaan.

- After about 700 meters turn right into the Van Leijenberghlaan.
- At the first traffic light (RBS Building) turn left into the Gustav Mahlerlaan.
- On your left you will see Symphony Building (orange).
- Turn left in front of the building into the Leo Smitstraat. On your right is the entrance to the car park (Q-Park).

From Den Haag / Haarlem

From ring road A10, take exit S109 Amsterdam Rivierenbuurt.

At the end of the exit go straight ahead (signposted Zuidas). Immediately turn left into the first road from the traffic lights. You are now on the Boelelaan.

- After about 700 meters turn right into the Van Leijenberghlaan.
- At the first traffic light (RBS Building) turn left into the Gustav Mahler Laan.
- On your left you will see Symphony Building (orange).
- Turn left in front of the building into the Leo Smitstraat. On your right is the entrance to the car park (Q-Park Symphony).

Park

You can park in the parking garage Q-park under the Symphony building. The entrance to the parking garage is situated at Leo Smitstraat 4, 1082 MP next to the Symphony building (east side). If this car park is full, you can make use of the nearby parking garage Mahler. In the garage, follow the signs Auditorium.

The entrance to **NIA** is located next to the Auditorium.
